### 2. To agree the minutes of the meeting on the 12 October 2020

### 3. Bude-Stratton Strategic Programme (BSSP)

Based on discussions at the recent BSTC Council meeting, it appears that the information recorded on the published schedule about the Climate Action project may need to be updated. RU advised that he had sent details to ZBJ.

### 4. Bude Area Community Network Panel

PT advised that he had asked Nicky Chopak (CNP Chair) for an opportunity to speak at the next meeting about the role of BCCT in the Bude Area.

### 5. BCCT future funding

The BCCT Board is drafting a proposal for a "Funding Agreement" that will be submitted to BSTC's Finance & Properties Committee for consideration at their meeting on 26 November as part of the Council's annual budgeting process.

The draft will be circulated to enable all BCCT members to put forward their ideas and views.

### 6. Updates on current BCCT projects – and related developments/initiatives

#### a) Climate Action Plan.

IS reported that the project was progressing, with 'Lead-in' funding having been received; the job vacancies have been advertised and an application to open a new bank account with the Cooperative Bank has been made.

#### b) Bude Business Voice.

TB reported that a new BBV website was up and running, supported by social media and press activity. TB reiterated that the CLLD grant required a focus on businesses in the defined 'core' area. It is hoped to hold a focus group event for the 15 selected businesses before Christmas.

**c) Crooklets to Summerleaze Cycle path.**

This project is on hold pending the outcome of BSTC's planning application and to allow for a period of public consultation.

**d) Creative Sector Economy.**

A meeting with three from the Creative & Cultural Economy Team at CC has been fixed for Tuesday 24 November. BCCT attendees are TB, JG and IS; it was agreed that PT should be invited.

**e) CIL Fund applications.**

As detailed in the Agenda, two applications have been submitted.

The Fund manager has invited the applicants for both projects to make a further brief presentation (5 minutes) later this month.

**f) Town Team.**

RU reported that some places on the Town Team had been agreed (including representation from BCCT) but that further work was being undertaken to involve town centre traders.

**g) Social Action Fund.**

Work continues, in cooperation with Neetside Community Centre. Funding support from CC Community Foundation, Blanchminster Trust and via Crowdfunding was being planned.

**h) Any other BCCT projects/initiatives**

JG suggested that the project to upgrade the Skatepark (one of the BSSP projects) needs to be progressed as it has the potential to improve leisure facilities for both locals and visitors, hopefully with outside funding support. Land needs to be transferred from CC to BSTC, and a planning application submitted.

**7. Any other business**

IS reported that BCCT had collaborated with Bude Cleaner Seas in a Crowdfunder appeal to raise funds for a Community Garden at Budehaven School.
