The Town Council has set up its own Economic Development Working Group of Councillors and they would very much like to get the Town Team up and running again, picking up the mantle of improving the town and its economic development.

We are suggesting some slight amendments to the terms of reference and membership – with the Chamber of Commerce and Jobcentre Plus being invited to join, along with a change in the representation from BCCT.

In the New Year, we'll be looking to set up a meeting to take stock and move things on.

**5. Updates on other matters – eg current BCCT projects and related developments/initiatives**

- BSSP - Bude-Stratton Strategic Programme.** The quarterly review meeting scheduled for 26 October 2021 was cancelled at short notice. BCCT has been told that arrangements for these meetings have been transferred from CC to BSTC.
- Bude Area Community Network Panel.** The next meeting is on Monday 7 March 2022. The notes from the meeting in December 2021 are attached.
- Bude Area Economic Development Plan.** The plan, renamed as Gwell – the community prosperity and wellbeing plan for the Bude area has been completed and handed over to BSTC. It is in two-parts – 1 The Evidence Base and 2 The Action Chapter.
- Bude Creative Economy project.** While the project is included in the Bude-Stratton Strategic Programme, there have been no developments since the review meeting on 27 June 2021.
- Bude Business Voice project.** TB to provide a brief update.
- Welcome Back Fund.** Tim Bagshaw has been working with BSTC and Bude TIC in relation to the 'Bude FebFest' tourism promotion project being led by Millie Heaven, the recently appointed TIC events coordinator.
- Places Called Home programme from National Lottery and Ikea Ltd.** As previously advised, BCCT's grant application (for around £4700) was successful and project implementation, jointly with Neetside Community Centre, is going forward.
