This email is to provide an update on recent developments. It comes with an apology if it duplicates information you have received via other channels.

## **1. BSSP meeting**

- a) As previously advised, there was a quarterly review meeting on Tuesday 26 Jan.
- b) This meeting overran – and part 2 will take place next Monday 1 Feb at 1 pm.
- c) One factor that caused the meeting to be longer than usual was the time taken to submit feedback from BSTC about their consultation exercise in relation to the projects within BSSP. There are two attachments.
- d) Another time-consuming discussion concerned the plans that form the basis for the BSSP. Those involved are aware that the BSSP is the schedule to the MoU (Memorandum of Understanding), the aim of which is the delivery of two plans, BSTC's Neighbourhood Devt Plan (NDP) and BCCT's Economic Plan (EP).
- e) To complicate matters, BSTC's review of the NDP is on hold pending changes to the planning system and while the EP is in need of updating (a lot has changed since 2018), time and resources were not available.
- f) It was suggested that it would be helpful to have a multi-level plan of some sort, encompassing the wider community network area, the action chapter of the NDP, other BSSP projects in Bude-Stratton, and activity stemming from the recently formed Town Team.
- g) As usual, after each BSSP meeting, Zoe updates the list of projects on the schedule – and this will be circulated to BCCT members.

## **2. Revising the EP**

- a) Following para f) above, the BCCT Board discussed how best to support the idea of a coherent and cohesive Bude area plan – and have submitted a proposal to the Town Council.
- b) A copy of this proposal (Revising the Economic Plan) is attached. Please treat this as **Confidential** as it has been seen only by BCCT Board, BSTC Cllrs and the Town Clerk.
- c) Item 13 on the agenda of BSTC Full Council meeting on Thursday (4 Feb) is "To agree the commissioning of BCCT to update the Bude Area Economic Plan"

## **3. Localism**

- a) My email of 18 Jan informed you of the launch of CC's Localism Vision & Strategy video event on Monday 25 Jan.
- b) I 'attended' and know that PT, AB and IS did as well – but it wasn't possible to know if other BCCT members had logged in.
